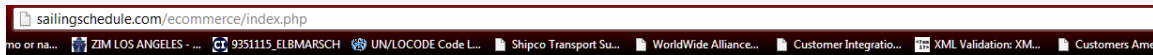
## SailingSchedule.com

## Sailingschedule.com Limitations:

### What we can:

- Header, Footer & Logo Images can be added to link using Stylesheet Admin.



- Schedule constraints can be added as per the user request.
  - Please Note that once we add constraint from Origin All to Destination All and user request us to remove specific city or country then we cannot remove it from front end. It also takes time from backend. Users are always requested to provide exact constraints they want us to add then it becomes easy to configure the link.
- Cut Off Padding can be added as per the user request. For example If we add cutoff padding of 2 days then link will display cutoff date 2 days earlier than actual cut off date.
- We can modify search label and schedule title as per user request.
